
making a natter box


You will need...

2 squares of thick paper or thin card.
They must be exact squares and one must be 1 cm smaller than the other.


- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Imagination




Choose two squares – one big, one smaller (by 1cm)




Use a ruler to find the middle point of your first square




Use a ruler to find the middle point of your square




It should now look like this




Now fold each corner in to touch the middle point – press down to make sharp creases and open out







Now re-fold one at a time and make an extra fold towards the middle point from each corner




Open it out and it should look a bit like this




Look for the square in the centre and mark each corner with a dot




Draw four lines, from the dots to the edge of the paper, then cut along these lines, up to the dot



It should look a bit like this!




Put some glue in the centre square




Fold these corners inwards to make the walls of your box

a should fold to touch a

b should fold over to touch b




Does it look a bit like this? Fold the sides of the box towards each other



Wrap the two pointed strips over and stick to the base of the box



Now repeat for the other square!
